Students are included in the program by registering for Computer Science courses.

The software includes:

- Developer Tools & Languages, e.g., Visual Studio
- Windows Development, e.g., Windows Vista and Windows Mobile
- Web Development including ASP.NET
- Server Development including SQL Server , Windows Server, and .NET Framework
